MEMBERSHIP FEE 2026

Information Letter no. 01-2026

Dear Member Federation,

This letter is to remind you that in accordance with Articles 1.17 and 1.18 of the EFC Statutes, which say:

*1.17. Member Federations must pay an annual membership fee, the amount of which is set by Congress. The fee, which cannot exceed EUR 2,000, must be paid **no later than 31 January in the year it falls due**. A late payment surcharge of 20% of the annual fee shall automatically be applicable in case of payment after this deadline.*

1.18. Notwithstanding article 1.17 above, a federation may only compete in an EFC championship after having paid its membership fee. EFC championships are European Championships of all categories, as well as those competitions determined as EFC championships by the Congress.

It means that participation of fencers on Cadet and Junior European Championships which will be held in Tbilisi will be possible only after receiving aforementioned payment on the EFC account.
